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NEW Chinese for Families School Policies For All New & Continuing Students

Registration & Information Privacy

- Registration & tuition payments are due prior to or on the first day a student attends class.
- Chinese for Families LLC does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies and other school administered programs.
- Each class has required & optional materials. Required & optional materials are billed in addition to tuition. Some optional materials are available from 3rd parties - supply lists & links are available on the Chinese for Families website.
- Payment may be made via personal check. A \$30 fee will be assessed for returned checks.
- All registration information is considered confidential & used only for the purpose of class billing, organization & record keeping. Registration information is not shared with 3rd parties beyond those required by law. If materials are ordered & shipped, name & address information will be shared with the order fulfillment & shipping company for the purpose of fulfilling the order. Chinese for Families does not rent or sell its student list.
- Withdrawals & Refunds
 - Students withdrawing by the end of the first week will receive an 80% refund on tuition only less \$20 administrative fee.
 - Students withdrawing by the end of the second week will receive a 60% refund on tuition only less \$20 administrative fee.
 - Withdrawals after the second week are not subject to refund but may be credited in part to future class sessions at the discretion of the school director.
 - Materials may be returned for a refund within the first week of class and must be in their original packaging. Shipping charges are not refundable. Damaged materials are not subject to refund.
- Makeup Classes - We are unable to schedule individual makeup classes. Refunds for missed classes will be made only in the event a makeup class cannot be scheduled due to cancellation based on weather. Class cancellations due to will be posted on the school website homepage, on the school telephone 610-716-1854 answering machine, & parents will be notified via email.

Student Drop off, Pick Up & Safety

- Students must be dropped off & picked up by a parent or authorized adult over the age of 18.
- Students will not be released to any other individual without written permission of the parent or guardian. Please provide a written note if your child will be dropped off or picked up by an adult other than the authorized parent or guardian listed on the registration form.
- Due to insurance requirements, students may not be transported to any location by any staff member of Chinese For Families.
- Due to insurance requirements, staff members of Chinese for Families will not change diapers. They may escort students to use the bathrooms. Parents are requested to remain on-site to assist with children who are in the process of toilet training.
- Parents are requested to wait for their children in the facility during the class period when possible.
- Chinese for Families does not maintain additional staff to babysit or watch children outside of class time. Children who remain past class time will be included in the subsequent class if one is scheduled. Parents who are late in picking up their children will be charged additional fees of \$25 per each $\frac{1}{2}$ hour.

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Immersion Policy (Do your best to avoid English during Class Time Please)

- Chinese for Families is an **Immersion Language** school. As parents we ask for your cooperation in making the immersion experience possible & beneficial for all students. Our goal is to enable families to learn as a team together.
- Children under the age of 6 will not be held to the immersion policy. Teachers will always respond in Mandarin to the children and we ask parents to also interact with your child in Mandarin as much as possible. The teachers will help you to do this during class time.
- Children over the age of 6 will be encouraged to avoid using English by participating in a "Chinese only during class time" game.
- If you do not wish to participate with your child in class, we ask that you wait outside the classroom. Parents are the model for language learning & their involvement or non-involvement is a crucial example for the children.
- Please turn off cell phones during class time.
- If your child is disruptive, we ask that you take your child outside of class to speak with them if you feel it is necessary.
- Please do not bring younger or older siblings who are not enrolled in the class to class. We offer classes for children of all ages and an age-appropriate class will be made available for all children who want to attend. Our Multimedia/Computer Lab is available for children who are not enrolled - please note that enrolled students will use the lab during their scheduled time for additional learning - they will be given preference in lab equipment use.

I, the undersigned adult student or parent/ legal guardian of the above child(ren) do give my permission and approval for his/her participation in Chinese For Families program(s) and therefore, assume all risks and hazards incidental to such participation. On behalf of myself, my child(ren) and family, I freely and voluntarily agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless, Chinese for Families, its directors, officers, administrators, teachers, and volunteers from any liabilities arising from any incident to my or my child(ren)'s involvement and participation in the school's program(s).
